

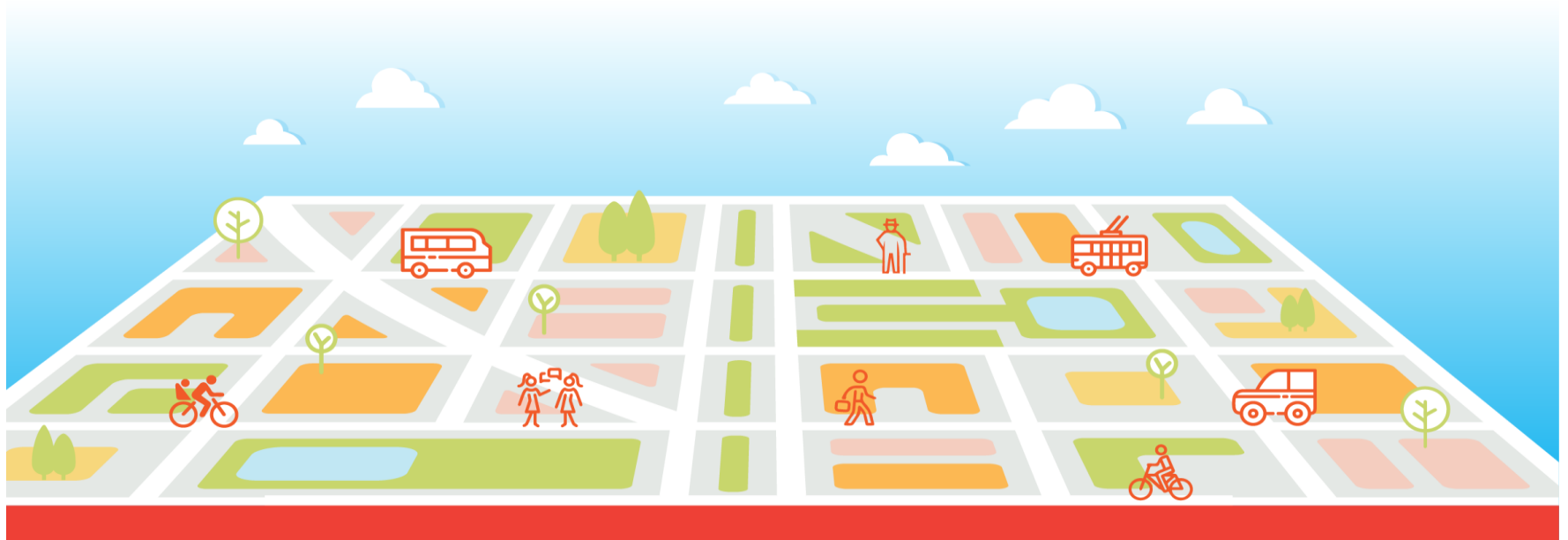

Southend-on-Sea is a seaside town, on the north side of the Thames estuary 40miles (64 km) East of Central London.

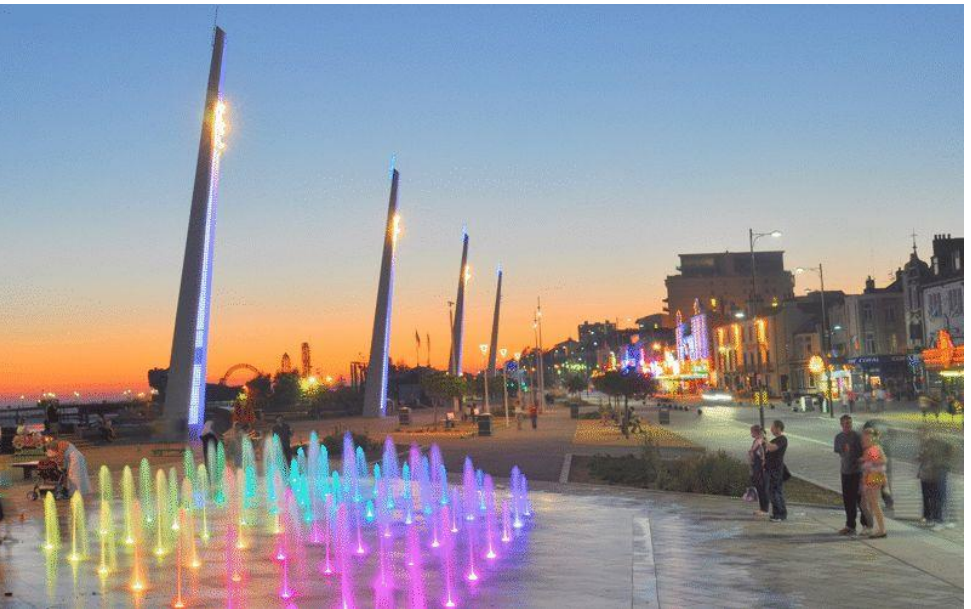

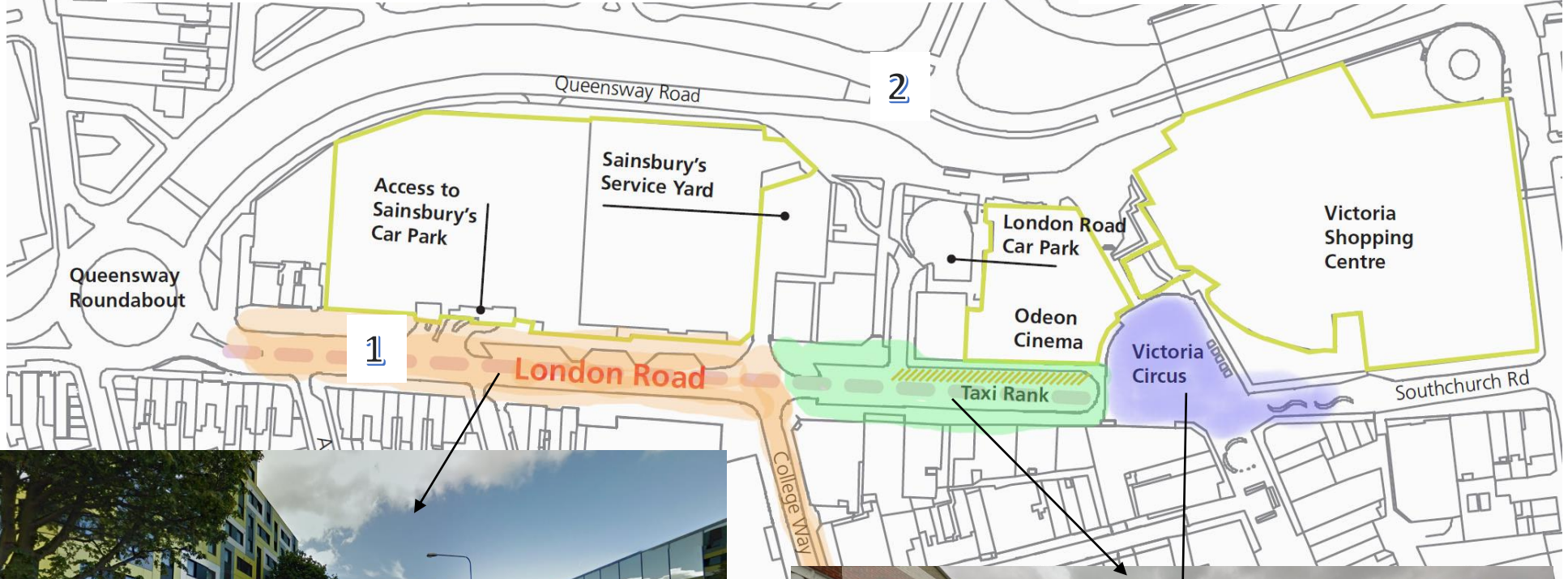

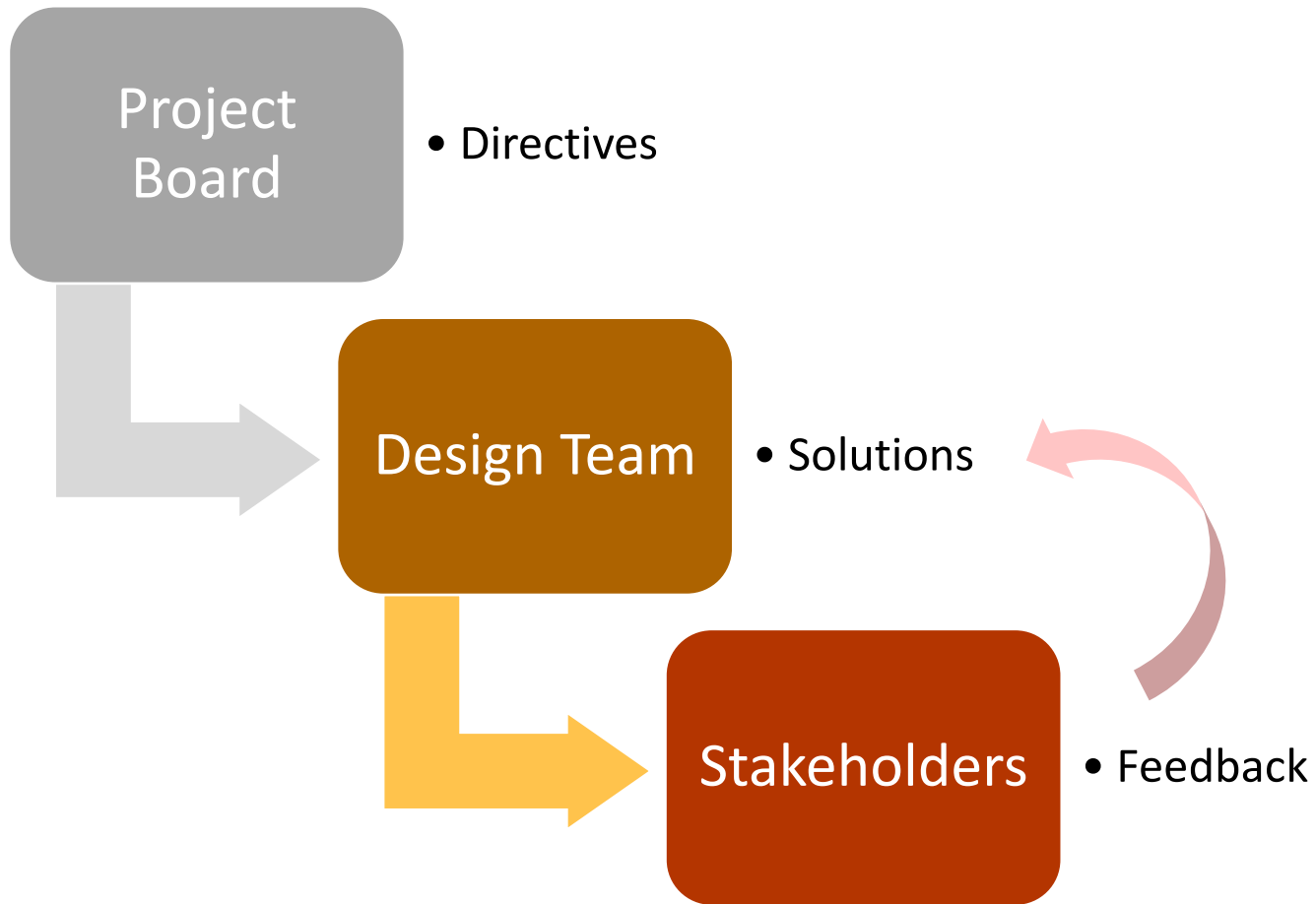

As you'll have noticed, work is well underway on the Pocket Places and Queensway-London Road scheme. This is our second community newsletter, designed to keep you updated while work is being carried out on site.

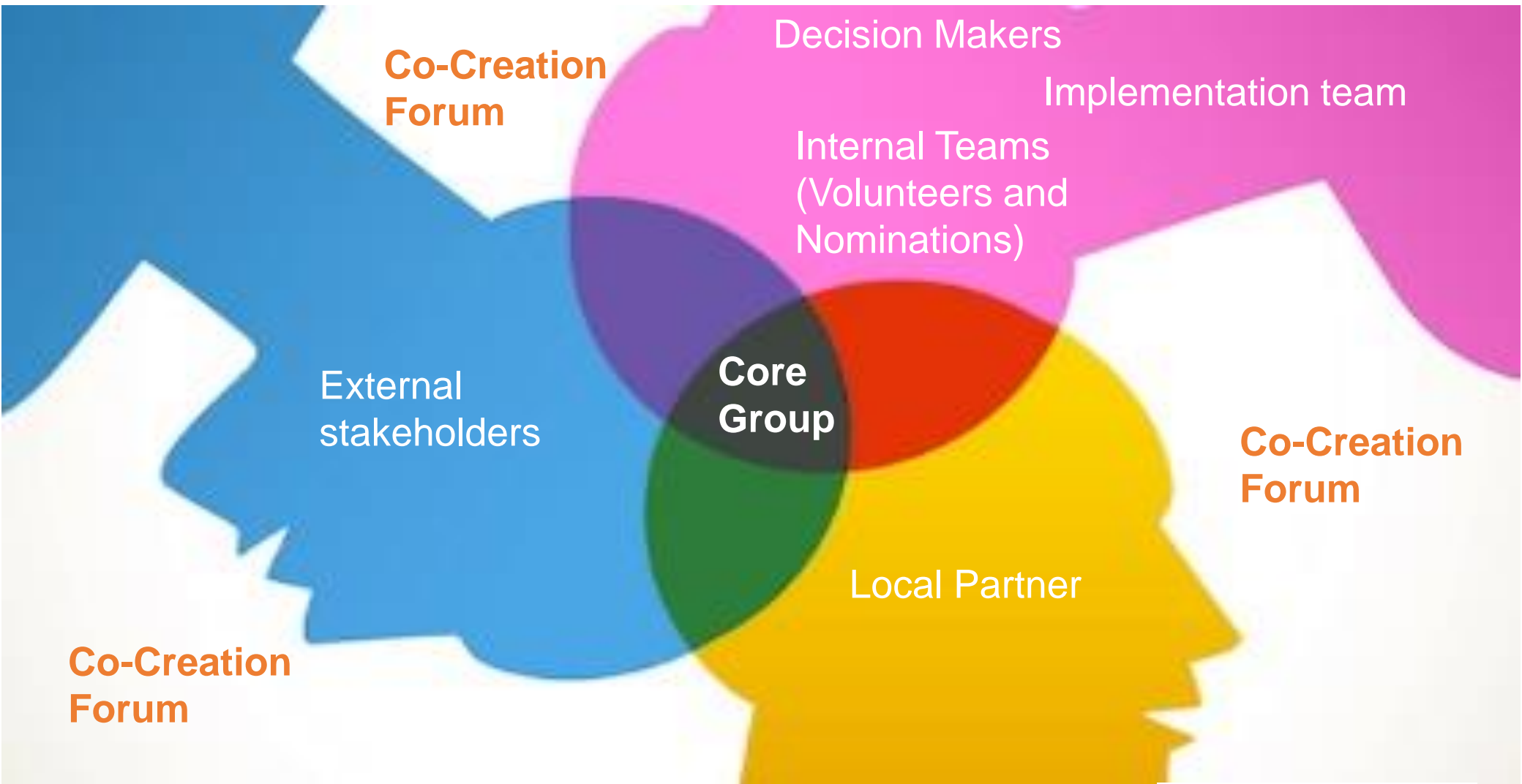
As we said in our first newsletter, the scheme includes the addition of more trees, green areas and seating at Victoria Gateway and the installation of new lighting to create a more welcoming experience and provide opportunities for community events. Over the past few weeks, work at the Gateway has focused on installing underground ducting for the new lighting fixtures. Once this was finished, the contractors restored the pavement to its original state so you could use it as normal while they worked on other parts of the scheme. From **Friday 1 August** the construction team will be back at the Gateway to install corduroy paving along the edges of the central plaza to assist blind and partially sighted users.

As part of the wider scheme, some extra planting, benches and cycle parking will be added along London Road, as well as widening the pavement in some of the narrower areas between the roundabout and Avenue Road/North Road. So we can widen the pavement, and to improve the drainage system, the team has already been working to realign the kerb of the central and splitter islands at the Queensway/London Road roundabout. They will now start work on the pavement south of the roundabout, between Princess Street and Ashburnham Road, realigning the kerb and de-cluttering the pavement. The roundabout will continue to be operational, with the outer lane closed off to allow the team to work safely.

They have also been installing new kerbs, block paving the parking bays and carrying out drainage works along the north side of London Road. With this now completed, they will start work on the south side from **Monday 4 August**.
