SUNRISE's offer: making your neighbourhood better places to live!

We are now in the last stages of this process, and we want to share our knowledge with as many neighbourhoods as possible. Next to the insight of the 6 SUNRISE neighbourhoods, we can offer you the guidance and assistance of the support partners urbanista, Rupprecht Consult, POLIS, TU Wien, Edinburgh Napier University - Transport Research Institute, Zaragoza Logistics Center and Koucky & Partners.

What do we offer?

- Our experts will co-create an individual neighbourhood playbook with you: this Co-Creation Scenario is a slide deck that brings together basic facts about the neighbourhood, selected methodologies for public involvement, mobility measures and ideas to fund and implementation these measures.
- The process will consist of 3 meetings:
 - Bilateral intake: you meet the SUNRISE expert to discuss the current status, ambitions, achievements etc. You will be asked to gather some information about the neighbourhood before this meeting. The approach will be lively and practical, starting from obvious challenges and day-to-day problems.
 - Solutions brainstorm session: based on the information gathered in the intake, the SUNRISE expert will present you different options in view of mobility measures as well as in cocreation methods.
 - Scenario definition: in the last meeting, the most useful solutions, and applicable cocreation methods are selected.
- All cities and neighbourhoods are invited to the **final workshop** on the 17th of June. Experiences will be shared, and results will be presented.

Which mobility measures is SUNRISE looking at?

SUNRISE has worked on 5 different types of mobility measures.

- Use and design of (public) (road) space for mobility (incl. innovative parking management)
- Mobility and accessibility for all, including children, youth, ethnic minorities, elderly etc. gender
- Innovative solutions to urban logistics
- Shared mobility (sharing of cars, bicycles, cargo-bikes, and collaborative provisioning)
- Facilitating active modes through comprehensive 'convenience' (infrastructure, information, campaigns etc.)

In addition, we can highlight COVID-19 aspects of these measure fields, as well as co-creation in times of COVID-19.







How to join?

Authorities dealing with neighbourhood mobility issues, as well as civil society initiatives with direct links to local governments within the countries of the H2020 European Research Area.

All meetings will be held online, no travel is required. We would only require your active involvement and your time to prepare for and participate in meetings. This would equal about 3 person days.

The working language will be English, or in any language the expert could cater for. Working documents will be in English.

About SUNRISE

SUNRISE is the acronym for Sustainable Urban Neighbourhoods Research and Implementation Support in Europe. The SUNRISE mission is to develop, implement, assess and facilitate co-learning about new, collaborative ways to address common urban mobility challenges at the urban district level through "neighbourhood mobility labs" and thus to lay the foundation for a Sustainable Neighbourhood Mobility Planning concept.

For four years, SUNRISE had its own empirical programme, that is, a carefully planned set of interventions in six "action neighbourhoods" within their respective city. Concretely, one neighbourhood each in the cities of Bremen, Budapest, Jerusalem, Malmö, Thessaloniki, and Southend-on-sea is running a highly participatory "co-creation" process with their residents and stakeholders to identify local needs, to develop new transport solutions, to implement and to evaluate them.
